



## **Membership Cost Breakdown**

Sterling Urgent Care provides a membership program for Employers and their employees and consumers.

If an employer is sponsoring the membership program, they will be billed directly for the costs of their employee memberships on a monthly basis. The employer and their company are responsible for their decisions on any costs assigned to their employees.

An employer must have at least three members signed up in order to participate in the employer contracting benefit.

As a consumer, a 12-month membership contract is required with an auto draft from a banking account.

As an employer/employee there are discounted fees that are required to be paid at the time of the visit. This includes \$15 per lab code, \$15 per x-ray code, \$10 per bottle of prescriptions, \$25 per DME, and the clinic fee schedule for vaccinations.

As a consumer, the discounted fees required to be paid at the time of the visit include: \$15 per lab code, \$15 per x-ray code, \$10 per bottle of prescriptions, \$25 per DME, and the clinic fee schedule for vaccinations.

Due to Utah law, we are not allowed to dispense our pre-filled bottled prescriptions to consumers in Utah.

Some Employers have elected to pay for some of the discounted fees for their employees. Please see the receptionist to determine if your employer has elected to do so.
